




Why a repair bonus?

The global quantity of e-waste is increasing at an alarming rate of almost 2 Million tonnes per year






The Global E-waste Monitor 2020






Repair bonus Leipzig increases motivation to repair



40%

Around 40 percent of the participants were motivated by the repair bonus to carry out additional repairs.

It was mainly households with lower incomes that were reached.

"Right to repair must not become a deceptive package"



- The right to repair needs a repair bonus
- Participation of manufacturers in repair costs
- Manufacturers must be obliged to provide consumers with repair information to consumers
- A repair index must be introduced throughout Europe
